Of the five handicap debutantes, Jinaam makes most appeal, stepping up in trip at a track where her full sister was victorious two years ago. Mawarid and Mazyonah definitely have the ability to be winnig a race of this nature if on a going day. The former is preferred providing he has no issues at the start However, a chance is taken on the joint top weight, All Monther, who on the whole has been fairly disappointing since winning his maiden here two years ago. That said, he races here off a career low mark and this represents a drop in grade but he will have to perform better than he did last season to take advantage.
